**Education Abroad Programs:** Students have unique opportunities to take UC Davis courses, taught by UC Davis instructors, in an international setting.

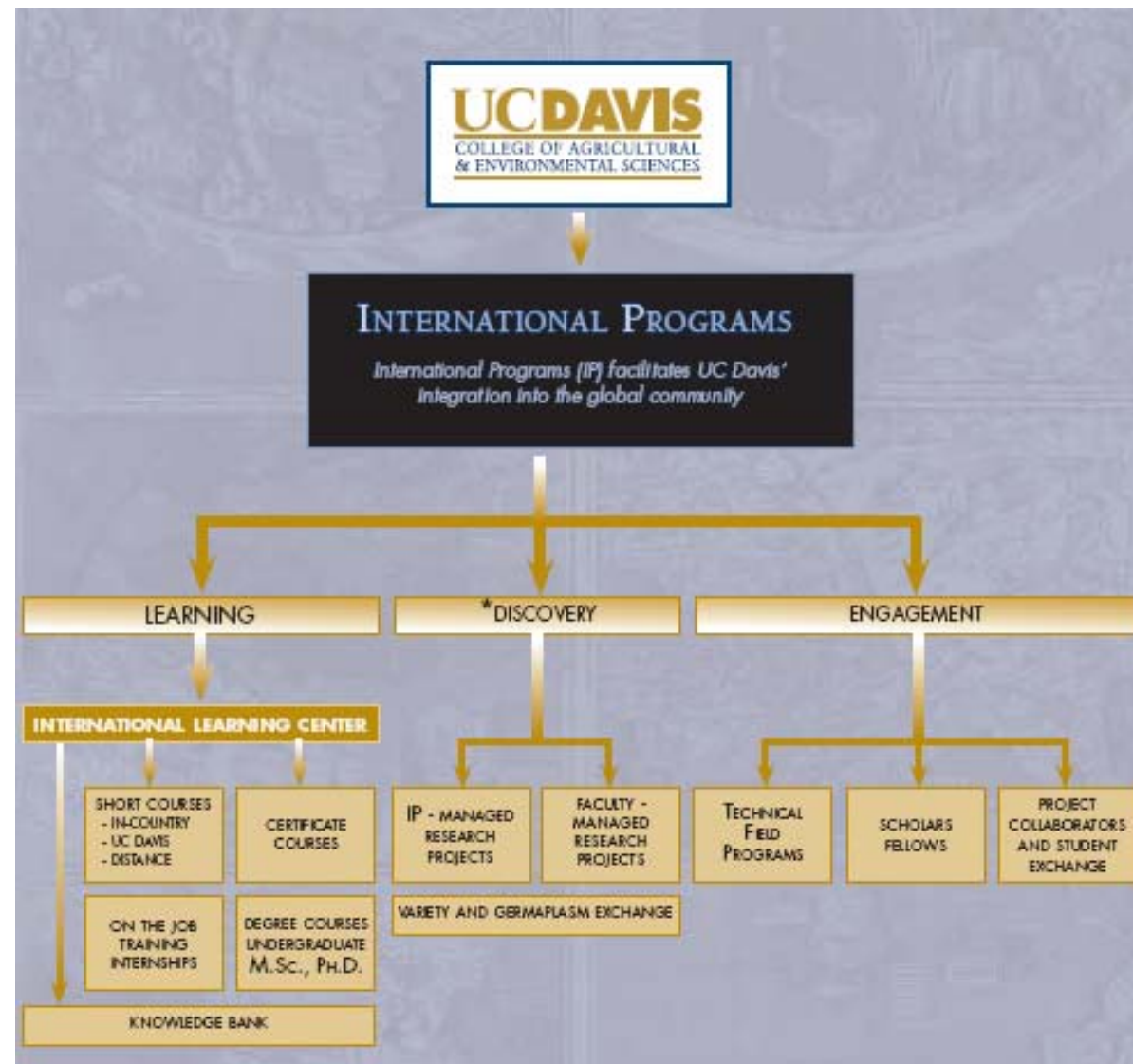
