

# Research and Innovation Fellowship for Agriculture

## The Program:

The **Research and Innovation Fellowship for Agriculture** (RIFA) program connects NGOs, research institutes and universities in developing countries with Master's and PhD level fellows from campuses across the University of California that possess expertise in agriculture, food systems and associated social and environmental issues. Fellows work with organizations to prepare materials and plan their projects prior to departure, spend **2-6 months in-country** with their hosts, and then complete final deliverables after returning home.

In its first 3 years, RIFA has sent 67 fellows to 24 countries. Projects have ranged from researching bean breeding strategies at CIAT in Colombia and mapping coffee value chains with CRS in Honduras to developing an on-farm welfare assessment tool for dairy farms in Sri Lanka with the University of Peradeniya.

## The Opportunity:

Now in our 4<sup>th</sup> year RIFA is looking to identify host organizations that would be interested in using the expertise of our fellows to help build out new or ongoing projects and programs. Student fellows are funded by our program for their airfare, \$1,000/month in-country for stipend and \$200 towards project costs.

## The Timeline:

Dec. 15, 2017	Host applications due. After each application is received, RIFA management will call hosts to clarify questions and verify applications.

May 4-May 8, 2018	4 day intensive project planning and preparation course
June 1, 2018-Mar 1, 2019	Fellows travel for periods ranging from 2 to 6 months to their host countries.
